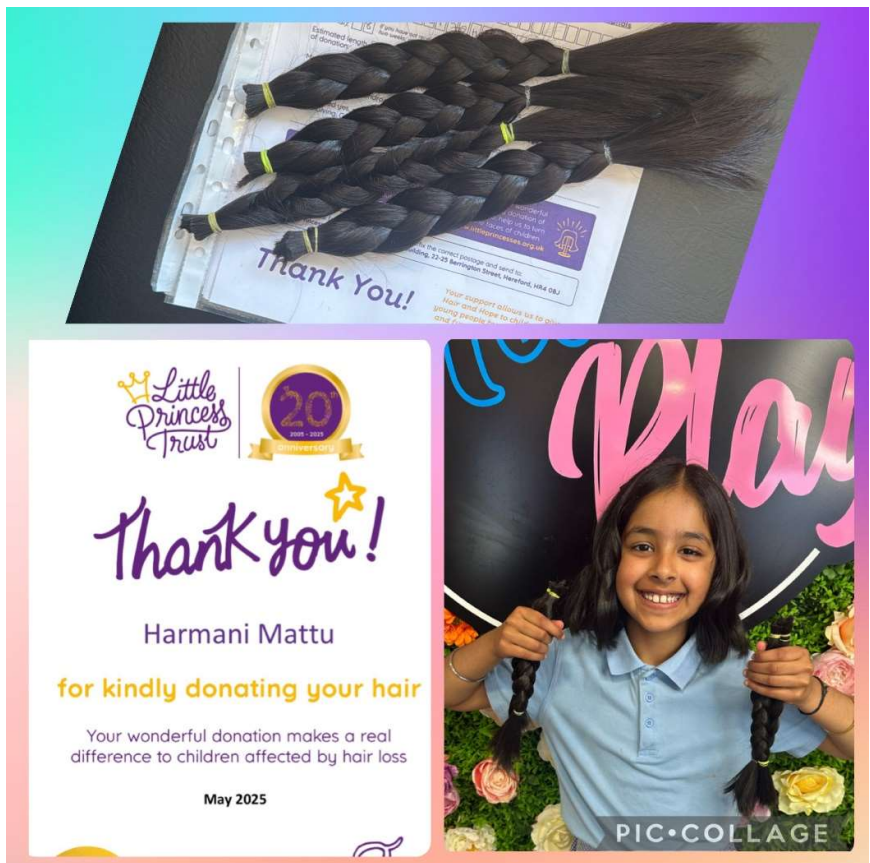


## Random act of Kindness

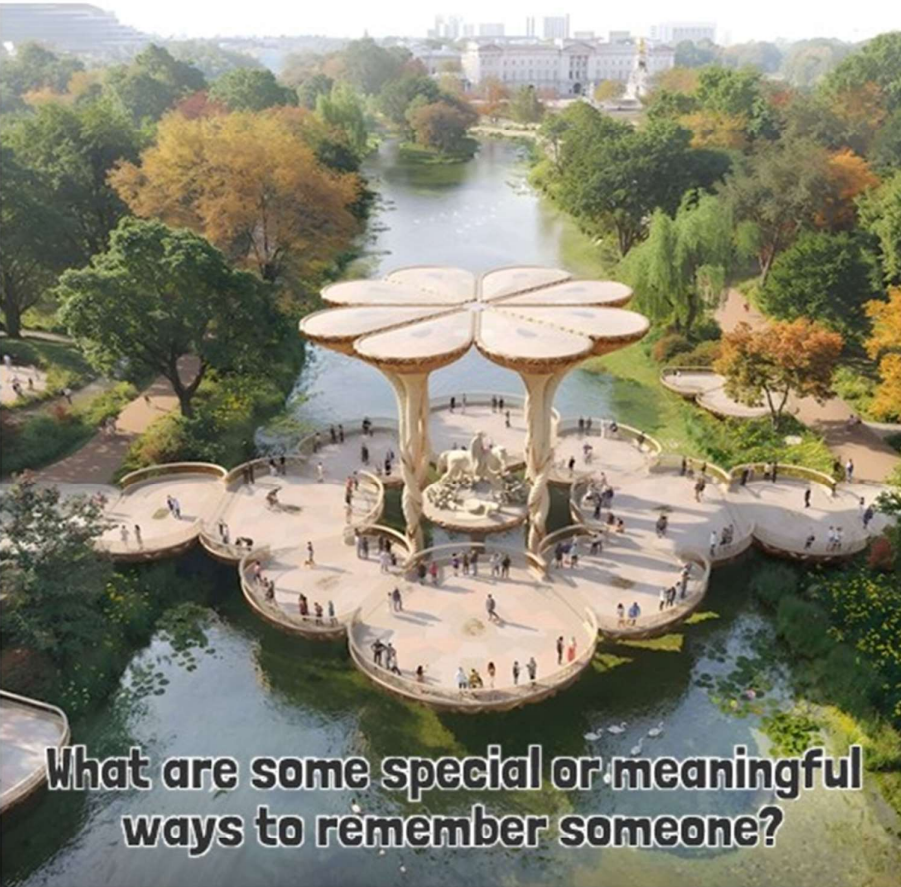


## In the news this week

The UK government has launched an online exhibition, to show five different designs for a new national memorial for Queen Elizabeth II.
