

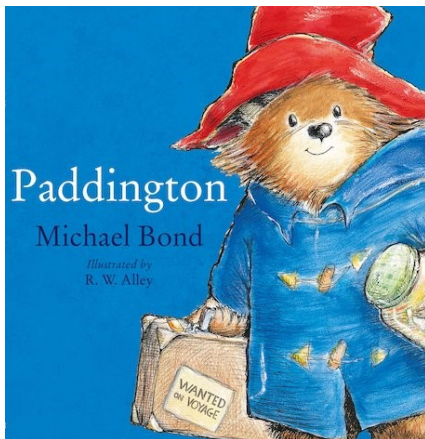
THE GREAT FIRE OF LONDON

Maths: This term it is really important that your child can:

- recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones)
- identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations, including the number line
- read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words
- count in steps of 2, 3, and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward or backward
- add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations, and mentally, including:
 - a two-digit number and ones
 - a two-digit number and tens
 - two two-digit numbers
 - adding three one-digit numbers
- identify and describe the properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes, including the number of edges, vertices and faces.
