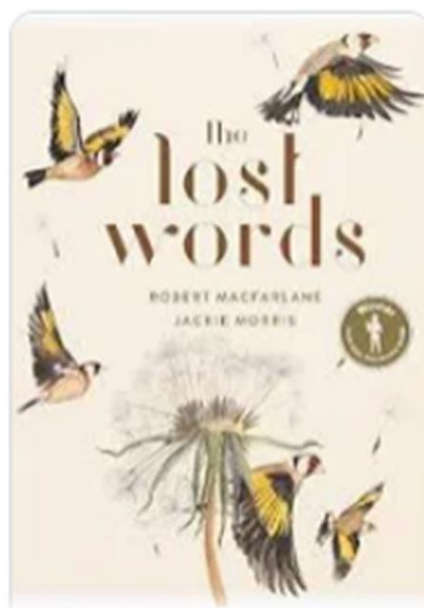
Please tell your children not to be too disheartened, we are proud of all of them and will make sure they all have opportunities for their voice to be heard at Spring Vale.
