Sports Uniform and Uniform shop dates



One of the huge successes of returning to school since the first school closure has been children coming to school in their sports kit on PE days. By coming in kit, children have gained at least an extra 15 minutes of activity during a PE lesson. There has also been zero cases of lost pumps or children going home in the wrong trousers! However, we must now formalise the PE uniform so that on PE days children come in Spring Vale sports kit. We have therefore decided to add a sports kit to our school uniform (modelled by Amber and Eleanor) which will be available to purchase from Ron Flowers over the summer holidays. The hoodie is £12.99 and jogging bottoms are £10.99. Children can then wear this kit to school on PE days from September.

Sports Days and restrictions

You should all have had letters regarding Sports days taking place on the following days:

We are hoping that the current covid restrictions are eased to allow for spectators but will know more after the Government briefing on Monday 14th June. If restrictions are in place, sports days will still go ahead but parents/carers/grandparents will be unable to watch.





Gates on Field

If you use the back entrance to school when bringing or collecting children, we will now be opening the gate on the field for parents to use. This will ease some of the congestion on the narrow pathway.

Absence reporting update

Any reported pupil absences for "any new ill health presentations" (not just the three typical Covid-19 symptoms of a fever, a new, continuous cough, or change to your taste or smell) as well as those who become unwell whilst at school are strongly encouraged to get a PCR test and not return to school unless the test returns a negative result and they feel well.

This means that if a child is unwell and off school with **any illness**, you are strongly encouraged to get a PCR test (full test at a test centre, not a lateral flow test at home) before your child returns to school. This will help to keep everyone safe in the last few weeks of term.
