## technology visit

In Year 3 and Year 6 this week, they had an exciting day of learning as they delved into the fascinating world of computing and coding. With the help of Squirrel Learning, the young minds took on the challenge that combined creativity, problem-solving, and technology. The day began with the students using Lego WeDo kits, which they eagerly assembled to build models. However, the true magic happened when they were introduced to the concept of programming. The children brainstormed and designed algorithms, step by step, to program their Lego models. They explored the fundamentals of coding, such as loops, conditions, and sequencing, discovering how their commands could make their creations move,



light up, and produce sounds. As they collaborated and shared ideas, the classroom transformed into a hub of innovation and excitement. The children learned the invaluable skills of problemsolving and resilience along the way.

#### Online payment system
