PORKING REMINDER

Please park considerately outside school when dropping off/collecting children. Please do not block residents drives and especially don't park anywhere it makes it dangerous for children and adults to cross the road, this includes on the yellow lines. You also need to check you have left enough room for an emergency vehicle (ambulance, fire engine etc) to get through.

Anyone collecting a child by car must never park on the zigzag road markings. This is a road traffic offence and you will receive a fine. The zigzags are there to keep children safe. Traffic wardens carry out random spot checks and have issued fines previously.



For the last couple of years we have been fully paying for coach transport for school trips out of the school budget. This was to reduce the cost of the visit to make them more affordable for parents. We will continue to do this for all trips up until Christmas but after that it will no longer be sustainable. From the spring term, we will revert to paying half towards coach transport, not the whole cost.
