School Direct Training Programme (salaried)

If you wish to apply for a place on the School Direct Training Programme (salaried), you are required to have at least three years' work experience in addition to the eligibility requirements detailed above.

Some schools may accept applications from high-quality graduates with less than three years' work experience, especially in maths, physics, chemistry, languages and computing. It will be for schools to decide whether they wish to accept applications from candidates with less than three years' work experience.

Schools will specify which skills and experience are important to them in their UCAS entry profile and marketing material. This experience may be in any career and does not have to be from an educational setting, but should generally apply to the years following graduation. You should contact your chosen school with any questions regarding your experience.

If you do not meet the eligibility requirements for School Direct, there are alternative <u>teacher training options</u> available to you.
