












If you have symptoms/ feel unwell or have taken a lateral flow and it is positive = Obtain a PCR test if symptomatic (Temporarily, a PCR is not necessary as of 11th January if you have no symptoms, LFD counts as positive. If symptoms develop, a PCR is then required.

How to use LFT tests to end isolation early

Self-isolation starts

This is the day your symptoms start OR when you have taken a lateral flow and it is positive but you have no symptoms – obtain a PCR test
