**If you have symptoms/ feel unwell or have taken a lateral flow and it is positive =  
Obtain a PCR test if symptomatic (Temporarily, a PCR is not necessary as of 11<sup>th</sup> January if you have no symptoms, LFD counts as positive. If symptoms develop, a PCR is then required.**
