🍪 Milk money for next term (£12) can be paid in to school by Thursday 19th December or online at any time over the Christmas holiday. All children over the age of 5 have to pay for milk unless you have successfully applied for free school meals with the Local Authority.

🍪 **Soccer 2000 for next half term (8th January to 12th February) is now available to be paid online. Please note we are NOT accepting any cash payments for this.**

🍪 100% attendance assemblies will take place next week during assembly time. Parents invited - you will have been notified by text if your child is receiving a certificate.
